We use an individualized, data-informed and evidence-based approach. Each child's family and caregivers are included as full partners during the program. OUR RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Clinical services provided by Master's-level therapists, including individual, family, and group therapy, as well as comprehensive case management.
- Specialized residential program available for adolescent girls 10–14 with acute behavioral health needs.
 Dialectical Behavior Therapy is a central component of this program.
- Significant collaboration with families and caregivers throughout the course of the program to support a successful transition home.
- Psychiatry services that oversee treatment and provide medication management as needed, and services to residents with their families.
- Enriching and therapeutic recreation therapy and programming.
- A gender-affirming environment for LGBTQIA+ community members.

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICES

Our program offers a caring milieu environment for youth. We embrace the use of Evidence-Based Practices shown to be effective in helping youth to heal from trauma, reduce distress, and build coping skills. Our clinicians are trained in the use of Cognitive Therapy, Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy, Ecosystemic Structural Family Therapy, and Dialectical Behavior Therapy.

EDUCATION

Youth participating in the Residential Treatment Program either attend Gemma's own Martin Luther School, an Approved Private School, the local public school, or another school best suited for their educational needs.
