Children, teens, and young adults up to age 21 who are experiencing emotional or behavioral challenges may benefit from our communitybased **Intensive Behavioral Health Services** (IBHS), a program that is designed to give each individual the tools they need to face challenges with a greater sense of strength and resilience.

Our services are provided primarily in the elementary and middle schools in the 19111 zipcode. For high schools, our services are provided for schools in the following zip codes: 19128, 19138, and 19150. Our goals are to streamline services, integrate with the school environment, collaborate with educators, increase family engagement, and link families to social services if needed.

Our team of Behavior Consultants and Mobile Therapists work with each child, youth, or young adult, and their family, to develop an individualized plan to address specific needs and difficulties.

SERVICES MAY INCLUDE:

- Assessment across settings that are typical for a child, youth, or youth adult.
- Functional Behavioral Assessments.
- Individual and family therapy.
- Behavior Consultation across home, school, and community settings to develop interventions to teach skills and improve overall functioning.
- 1:1 individual support in a specific identified setting with a Behavioral Health Technician to teach skills.
